### Statement Of Conditions From Which You Seek Relief

I, the person signing below, say under oath that I am the applicant for this Civil Protection Order and state I have been the victim of sexual abuse, sexual assault or stalking (as described in sections 53a-181c, 53a-181d and 53a-181e of the Connecticut General Statutes) by the respondent as follows: **(Explain for each incident: (1) what happened, (2) when it happened, (3) where it happened, and (4) who was there when it happened.)**

The Respondent, Kelly Grohs has made false accusations of sexual abuse against Marc Frenzel, starting in September 2012. DCF made investigations as to these false allegations and found them to be unsubstantiated. These false accusations forced a then 10 year old boy to be removed from his home for 88 days upon false allegations.

These false accusations again occurred in September 2015 and once again they were found to be unsubstantiated by DCF.

Now, two years later the respondent, Kelly Grohs, begins to make more false allegations against Marc. The Respondent is providing false and misleading information to others and that information is now being posted on a public blog ([www.familycourtcircus.com](http://www.familycourtcircus.com)) and within these false and defaming statements the Respondent is referring to Marc as a pedophile and a predator. In one blog dated September 3, 2017 it is specifically stated Marc's full name, his grade, his school, and a picture of him. In other blogs she has provided the full address to Marc's home. She identifies him as an initial predator of sexual abuse. The Respondent then shares copies of this blog on Facebook and requests others to post and share. She has contacted his school and sent letters/emails to others associated with the school to be aware of him and afraid of him. Numerous classmates approached him and asked him if he was a pedophile.

Marc has become anxious and fearful as he is now approached by others who are making statements to him and questioning his behavior and calling him names.

The Respondent most recently continues to show up at the neighbors house on a regular basis, three or more time in one week and stands at the edge of the property line and stares at Marc while he is outside playing, doing yard work, etc. The Respondent continually showing up at the neighbors to stalk Marc and has been standing in the yard staring at Marc through the bushes and giving him dirty looks. Marc has increasingly become afraid and is now extremely fearful of going outside and doing anything outside. Besides standing in the yard and staring at Marc, the Respondent will drive to the neighbors house and pull in and sit in the driveway stalking Marc at the times that he is scheduled to be off the bus from school so that she can stare at him as he walks into his home. The Respondent is stalking Marc on a regular basis.

In light of all the Respondent's irrational, abusive and bullying behaviors, Marc has become terrorized by this woman, increasingly afraid to go to school, to take the bus or even step outside of his own home. Each day he lives in a world of fear and anxiety because of the behaviors of this irrational woman.
