All parties, counsel and the GAL appeared on May 1, 2020 for a continuation of the hearing on the granted ex-parte custody request (#167). After the proceedings concluded, but before a further hearing date was assigned, the defendant retained different counsel and the GAL indicated to the court (via case flow) that the parties were attempting settlement. On June 2, 2020 the court convened a remote status conference. All counsel and the GAL participated in the status conference and indicated their continued efforts towards settlement and their collective desire to delay any further hearing dates until they had exhausted their settlement efforts.

In light of that request the court issues the following temporary orders:

- 1. The hearing on the granted ex-parte custody request (#167) is continued.
- 2. Until the hearing is complete, or until further order of the court, the father has sole legal and physical custody of the children.
- 3. Until the hearing is complete, or until further order of the court, the mother may not have any contact with the children, directly or via third parties. She is not to respond to any contact the children might initiate. The father may reinforce this no contact order via the children's phones and electronic devices as he deems appropriate.
- 4. The father will provide the mother with daily updates regarding the children via Our Family Wizard.
- 5. If the parties have not submitted an agreement for court approval by July 1, 2020 the hearing on the granted ex-parte request (#167) will continue on a date assigned by the court.
